

# THANK YOU FOR YOUR PURCHASE OF THE VINTAGEVIEW® WINE RACK.

Model #'s WS31, WS32, WS33, WS41, WS42, & WS43

The VintageView® is simple to install using just a level, a wine bottle and a drill with phillips screwdriver bit. Follow the directions and diagram below to install your new wine racks.

## Step 1:

Measure a minimum of 2 3/4" to the right from the left side of your mounting area. Place either the neck or base side of first rack with the centerline at the measured distance. Mark location of mounting holes.

## Step 2:

Measure 7 1/2" to the right of your first hole locations and mark hole locations, at frame centerline, of the other side of your first rack.

## Step 3

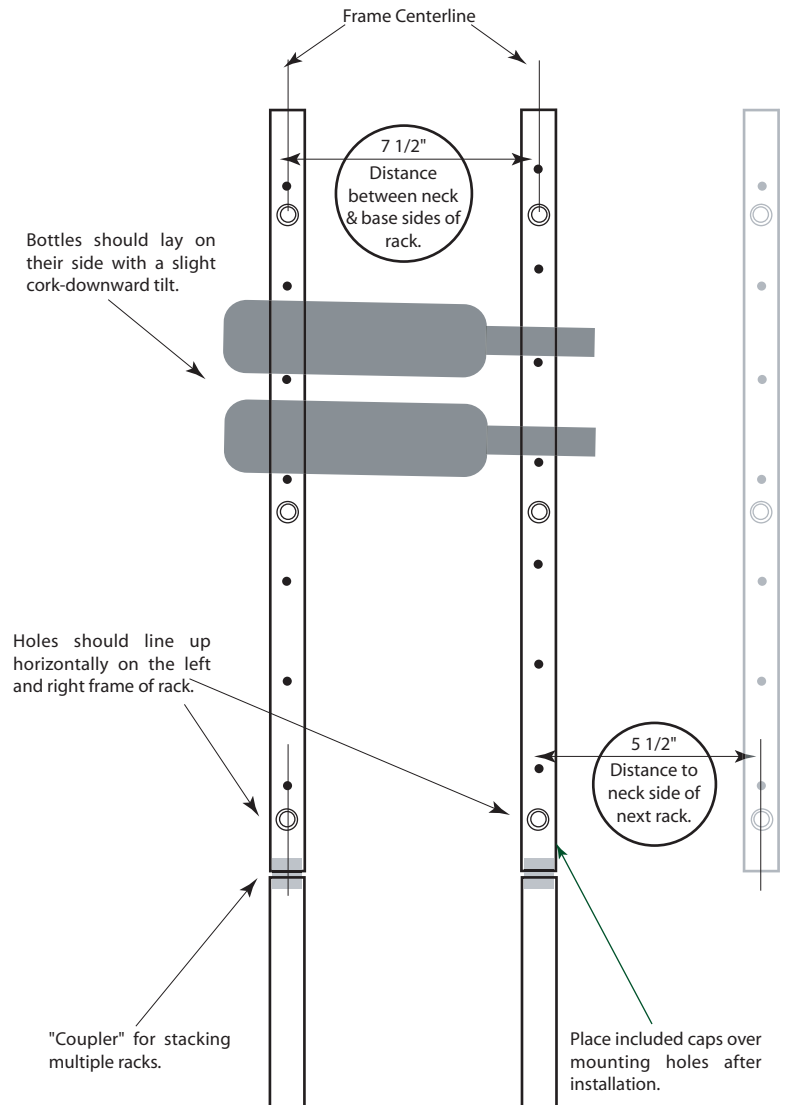
If mounting multiple racks side-by-side, measure 5 1/2" over from the right hole locations on your first rack and mark the hole location for either the neck or base side of your next rack. Follow the above steps and distances (7 1/2" between neck and base sides of each rack, 5 1/2" between sets of racks) for the balance of your mounting area.

## Step 4

Once all hole locations are marked, insert fasteners starting at the left side of your wall and attach racks. Before fully tightening fasteners, make sure to 'plumb' your racks with a level to insure that they are attached completely straight on the wall.

## Step 5 (Optional)

If stacking multiple racks one above the other, use the included coupler between upper and lower racks.



## Helpful Hints

Mounting holes should be at the same height.

Rods can be gently bent to level the bottles.

Distances between racks may be increased, or slightly decreased, according to personal preferences and to center racks on your wall.

## FASTENERS

There are six pre-drilled mounting holes for fasteners on each set of racks, three holes per side - neck and base. Each fastener must support less than twenty pounds, of which most is in shear force (vertical pressure down on the wall). The top fastener has the most pull out force (horizontal pressure away from the wall). When installing wall strips ALWAYS make sure the top fastener is solid.

We do not include fasteners with your racks because we never know what surfaces the racks will be attached to. However, we recommend the following fasteners:

Wood Surface: #8 x 2" wood screw

Drywall/Wallboard Surface\*: #8 x 2" wood screw with spiral inserts and/or toggle bolts and molly bolts

Concrete and Brick Surface: 3/16" x 1 3/4" masonry screw (ie: Tapcon®)

Stucco Surface: 3/16" x 1 3/4" masonry screw (ie: Tapcon®)

\*Many people are concerned about mounting the VintageView™ racks onto drywall with only spiral inserts. If you are concerned about this we suggest using a Toggle bolt or Molly on the top mounting holes and spiral inserts on the bottom two mounting holes.
